## **ACER**

I had to replace my laptop, after much research I choose the Acer R7-572. It is larger than what I wanted, but it has worked out beautifully. Used, but the last model in the line.



- Windows 8.1 The owner had upgraded to Windows 10 Pro, which would have been my first upgrade anyway. Which saved me money.
- Intel® Core™ i5-4210U processor Dual-core 1.70 GHz obviously not for gaming would want an i7 and 2-3 or greater GHz, but, way more than adequate for general use.
- 15.6" Full HD (1920 x 1080) 16:9 IPS I had wanted 13" or less.
- Intel® HD Graphics 4400 with Shared Memory
- 8 GB, DDR3L SDRAM Can be upgraded to 16 GB but 8 seems to be working just fine.
- 1 TB HDD the owner removed and replaced the HDD with two drives, 117 GB C drive and a 300 GB D drive. I had not realized how much faster SD drives were over HDD drives until now. I will replace both with larger ones once I can afford them.

The previous owner (eBay, \$200 less than retail, he needed the money for a gaming machine, since I don't game it worked out to both our advantages) he had already replaced the wifi (for internet/network/printer) and Bluetooth (for my wireless headphones) adapter which had been a reported problem with the R7 model, it works perfectly with both. Again, saved me money up front.

Following photos are off Acer's site, you'll notice first off the unusual hinge mount in the center of the back so that it has a full swivel capability. Front to reversed back and every angle in between:



Notice the keyboard touchpad reversal, this is the main item that all the reviewers could not wrap their heads around and accept. On all my laptops I have never used a touchpad, always using a wireless trackball mouse, even on my desktops. This hinge arrangement allows me to bring the screen closer to me with the leading edge setting down midway on the keyboard portion of the laptop between the keyboard and touchpad.



My first upgrade a wolf skin, applied to back, keyboard and around the screen edge.





Left is the position I favor the most, the wireless mouse I prefer with my Bluetooth headphones. Bottom left just showing the screen pivoted half way over. Bottom right screen flipped all the way over showing the entire keyboard/touch pad base.
