Chimney Spire, usual occurrence with the water running through the granite.









El Capitan



































Preceding page was North Dome (the rounded one) across from Half Dome.


Half Dome was once a full rounded dome as well, but the force of the last glacier that came through sheered off half of the mountain.

































Everywhere you look you can see the sheering force of glaciers.











































































































Prologue
